

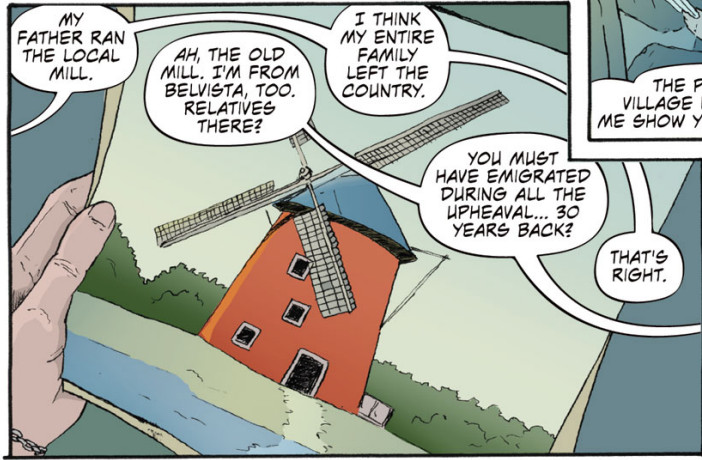

I'M VISITING THE PLACE I WAS BORN. A VILLAGE NAMED BELVISTA. LET ME SHOW YOU SOME PICTURES...



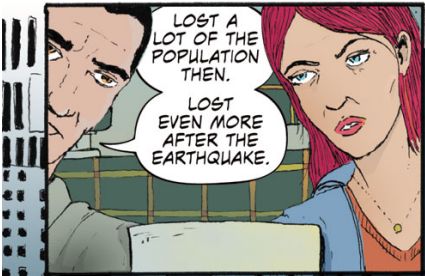
MY FATHER RAN THE LOCAL MILL.

THAT'S RIGHT.

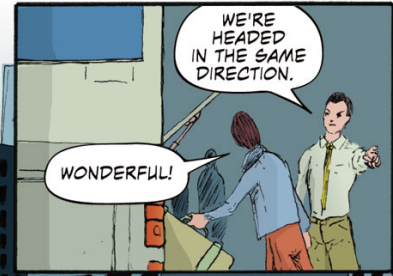


LOST A LOT OF THE POPULATION THEN.
